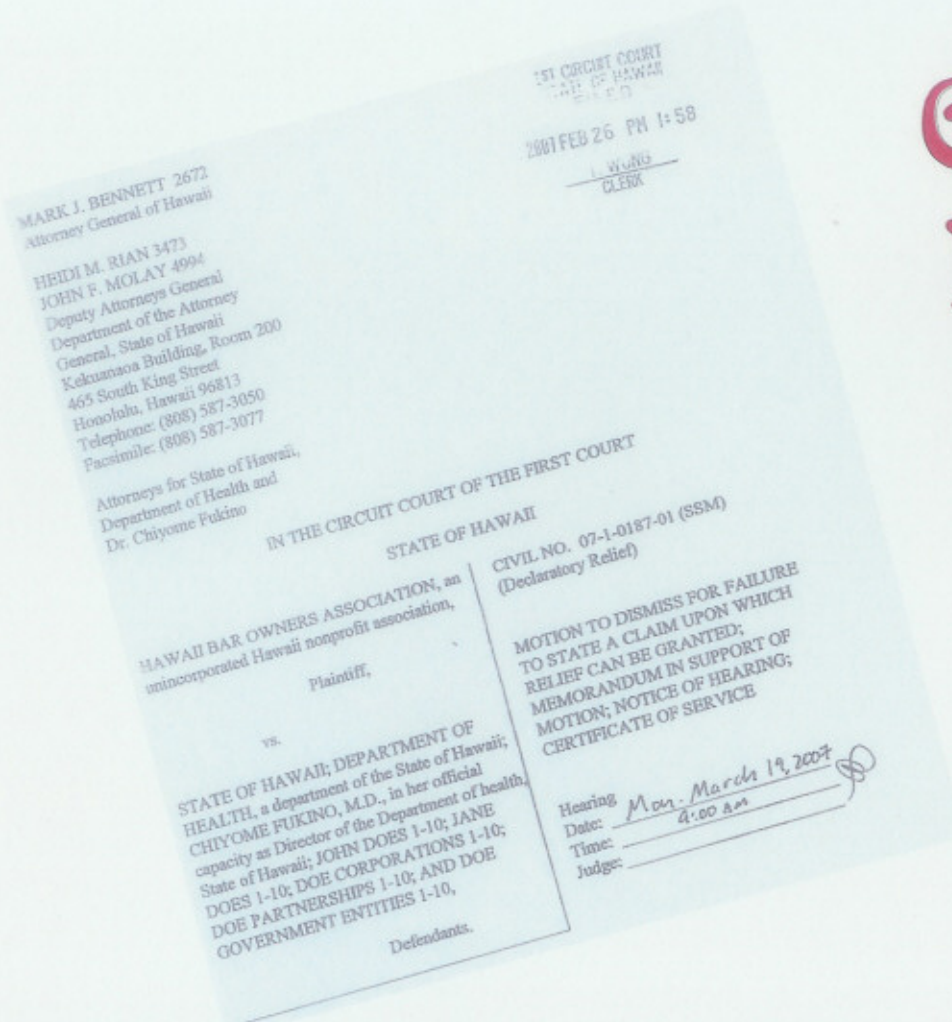


Great News for Bar Owner's!!!

Straight from the Attorney Generals Office.
Bar Owner's or Operator's are not responsible for enforcing the smoking ban. They simply have to post no smoking signs, and inform the smoker that they are breaking the law.



The enforcement of the law as to those persons who persist in smoking in the bar or tavern after being advised of the provisions of chapter 328J, HRS, is not placed onto the shoulder of the owner or operator of a bar or tavern, but is left up to either the police, or to duly appointed personnel from the Department of Health. See HRS §§ 328J-12(a) – (e).
